**As jy 'n volgeling van Jesus is, sê Hy self, moet jy sout en lig vir die wêreld wees.**

**“UNchristian” \*\***

Hierdie boek ontleed en bespreek navorsing wat in 2007 in die VSA gedoen is oor *“what a new generation thinks about Christianity... and why it matters.”* Die drie mees algemene persepsies wat jongmense in die VSA van Christene het, het die studie bevind, is dat Christene ervaar word as anti-homoseksueel, as veroordelend [“judgmental”] en as skynheilig. Verder nog: Christene is uit pas met die werklikheid, hulle is

onsensitief vir ander mense en hulle is veroordelend teenoor ander godsdienste. Die konklusie: *“Christianity has an image problem.”*

Is ons anders? Het mense in Suid-Afrika 'n meer positiewe persepsie en ervaring van Christene? Word Christene se invloed in die samelewing ervaar soos dié van sout en van lig - iets waarsonder die samelewing en wêreld baie slegter af sou wees?

## The NEXT Christians

Dieselfde instituut publiseer drie jaar later nog 'n studie onder die titel *“The NEXT Christians: How a New Generation is restoring the faith.”* Dit vertel verhare van jong Christene wat die post-Christendom wêreld waarin ons vandag lewe, aanvaar en probeer om konstruktief en kreatief sout en lig te wees – juis as navolgers van Jesus Christus.

Hulle probeer om “restorers” te wees: mense wat met hulle lewens en gedrag hierdie wêreld help herstel sodat dit kan wees wat God bedoel het. Hulle verstaan dat “sout en lig wees” veral te make het met lewenstyl en om op 'n positiewe manier God se liefde en genade en geregtigheid in die wêreld in te dra.

## In plaas van die donkerte te vloek, steek hulle liever kerse aan.

Dit is die manier, sê Gabe Lyons, hoe die “next Christians” in hul konteks betrokke is. Hulle is “creators, not critics”, hulle kies doelbewus “engagement over condemnation”, “grace over judgment”, “courage over comfort”, “faithfulness over reputation”. Hulle lewens “is postured by prayer, instead of power”. Hulle maak tyd

om te bly drink uit die Bybel as Bron vir hulle lewens.

“As culture drives the masses toward a me-centered existence, the practice of prayer is posturing the next Christians to remember who really sits at the center of their lives and faith.”

“Back when we did these big crusades in football stadiums and arenas, the Holy Spirit was really moving – and people were coming to Christ as we preached the Word of God... But today, I sense something different happening. I see evidence that the Holy Spirit is working in a new way. He’s moving through people where they work and through one-on-one relationships to accomplish great things. They are demonstrating God’s love to those around them, not just with words, but in deed.”
